Hamaro dhan, Radhey Ju ko nam.

The sole treasure of my soul is the Shree Radhey's name.

राधे नाम प्रताप श्याम भये, रसिकन में सरनाम ।

Radhey nam pratap Shyam bhaye, rasikan men sarnam.

The Grace of Shree Radhey name made Krishna famous among all Rasik Saints.

राधे नाम सिद्ध करि मुरली, तानन मोह्यो बाम ।

Radhey nam, siddha kari murali, tanan mohyo bam.

It was the charm of Radhey name that Krishna imbued
in His flute and that fascinated all the Gopis with its sound.

राधे नाम कृपा ते द्वापर, रास रच्यो ब्रजधाम ।

Radhey nam kripa te dwapar, raas rachyo braj-dham.

With the Grace of Radhey name Krishna was able
to do maharaja's leela in Braj in the age of *dwapar*.

राधे नाम सुनत ही भाजत, हरि अधीर तेहि ठाम ।

Radhey nam sunat hi bhajat, Hari adheer tehi tham.

Whenever Krishna hears 'Radhey', He impatiently runs to that place.

राधे नाम रकार बिना रह, श्यामहुँ आधे श्याम ।

Radhey nam rakar bina raha, Shyam-hun adhey Shyam.

If you remove 'r' from Radhey, Radhey Shyam
becomes 'adhey' Shyam (Krishna becomes only half, *adhey*).

करु 'कृपालु' राधे राधे की, रटना आठों याम ॥

Karu 'Kripalu' Radhey Radhey ki, ratna athon yam.
